


THE SERIAL PSYCHIE

EPISODE ONE - SEXUAL SADISTS: RAPE, TORTURE, KILL

Sadly, Sexual Sadists are the most common breed of these monsters. These killers are addicted to the thrill of inflicting pain on their victims before they finally murder them. Sometimes the torture is brief. Other times it's prolonged. Like most serial killers, these murderers will continue their heinous crimes over and over again, until they are captured or killed.

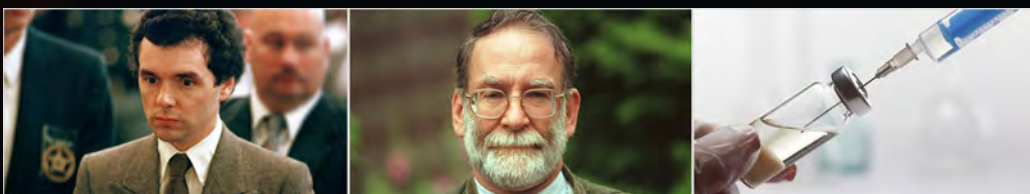
Episode One will feature one of history's most heartless murderers, David Parker Ray. He was known as the Toy Box Killer because of his gruesome, homemade torture chamber he nicknamed his "Toy Box." The Episode will contrast his twisted psyche with other serial sadists like Ted Bundy, John Wayne Gacy and the infamous BTK Strangler, Dennis Rader.



EPISODE TWO - ANGELS OF DEATH

This is a surprisingly common type of serial killer - doctors and nurses who kill patients repeatedly. Many of these murderers have continued their brutal crimes for years before they are caught. They often disguise their acts by appearing to heroically attempt to save their dying victims. This Episode features a physician and serial killer, Harold Shipman, who murdered more than 200 victims and earned the nickname, Doctor Death. Shipman is perhaps the most prolific serial killer of all time.

This Episode compares Shipman's crimes and psychology to other Angels of Death like Donald Harvey, a hospital orderly who spent more than seventeen years heartlessly murdering patients, sometimes by horrific means. Also, remarkable stories of hospital nurses who enjoy wielding the god-like power of deciding when someone lives or dies.



EPISODE THREE - EXTREME KILLERS: ABANDON ALL HOPE

These are most excessive Sexual Sadists who torture in the extreme and then cross over into horrible perversions like mutilation, necrophilia and cannibalism. This Episode also covers the Psychotic Killers who are not the cold-calculating murderers like most serial killers – these monsters have total broken from reality, in the most horrific ways.

Kevin Bianchi, the Hillside Strangler, will be featured for his heinous crimes as well as his brilliant efforts to convince the courts his warped mind was possessed by multiple personalities. Ed Gein, the inspiration for Psycho, as well as history's legendary madman, cannibal and serial killer Albert Fish will be analyzed in this pulse-pounding Episode.



EPISODE FOUR - RAGE AND REVENGE

This Episode explores "The Most Dangerous Animal of All" - human beings. These are the serial killers who are not necessarily motivated by sex or torture. They are driven by a far-reaching hatred for humankind. Some are on a mission to rid the world of certain types of people. Others are obsessed with revenge for their psychologically damaging childhoods. And then there are some that simply Love to Kill.

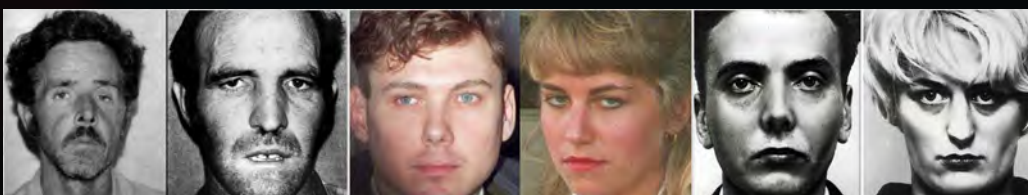
Featured in this Episode is the monster called America's Most Meticulous Serial Killer, Israel Keyes. Keyes operated out of Alaska, but traveled throughout the United States for decades slaughtering victims and cleverly covering his tracks so the police had no clue a serial killer was even on the loose. Keyes' psychology will be compared to other criminals of this ruthless breed like the Night Stalker, Richard Ramirez and the Yorkshire Ripper, Peter Sutcliffe and the Gainesville Ripper, Danny Rolling. The current Mass Killers will also be explored.



EPISODE FIVE - UNITED WE KILL

These are serial killers that work as a team. These monsters fuel off each other's warped psyches and commit serial murders they would never carry out on their own. Sometimes it's a man and woman, other times two men. Often this deadly chemistry causes the murders to increase in frequency and brutality over time. These cases include some of the most shocking crimes of ever recorded.

Ian Brady and Myra Hindley, England's notorious Moors Murderers will be featured as well as other deadly duos like Charles Ng and Leonard Lake, Ottis Toole and Henry Lee Lucas and Paul Bernardo and Karla Homolka, Canada's vampirish Ken and Barbie Killers.

Dr. CHARLES HELLER

Forensic Psychologist and Expert Witness with extensive court experience in Civil, Criminal and Family Court cases. Currently a forensic psychologist on staff at Rutgers University Biomedical Health service, specializing in criminal behavior and risk assessment as well as a forensic psychologist consultant for the Rockland County (NY) court evaluation service, where he has performed hundreds of child custody, as well as criminal competency and child abuse/neglect evaluations.



Ph.D. KOSTAS A. KATSAVDAKIS

A licensed Psychologist and diplomate in Forensic Psychology with the American Board of Professional Psychology. He has extensive experience in Forensic Evaluations, the Clinical assessment and treatment of juveniles and adults and threat assessment and management. Dr. Katsavdakis is retained by Prosecutors, defense attorneys and the state/Federal Court to evaluate defendants charged with violent sexual and violent non-sexual crimes followed by testimony in Court.



PROF.RODERICK BROADHURST

A graduate of the University of Western Australia (Phd) and University of Cambridge and formerly with the Department of Corrective Services and Health Service in Western Australia. Appointed Senior Fellow, Crime Research Centre at the University of Western Australia in 1990. In 2005 he took the post at the QUT as Head of School of Justice, followed by visiting Professor Griffith University in 2008. In 2009 he was appointed Professor at the Australian National University Regulatory Institutions Network, Fellow of the Research School of Asian and Pacific Studies and Chief Investigator ARC Centre for Excellence in Policing and Security until 2013. Currently Professor of Criminology, School of Global Governance and Regulation [REGNET] Research School of Asia and the Pacific. He has worked with a wide variety of criminal justice agencies, in Australia, China and Cambodia and Directs the ANU Cybercrime Observatory.



RICHARD FRANKEL J.D.

An Assistant Professor in the Division of Criminal Justice, Legal Studies, and Homeland Security. Mr. Frankel's government service began as Assistant District Attorney for Suffolk County, NY. He served for more than 25 years in public service, the majority of his career with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. A recognized authority in complex investigations, asset recovery, cyber issues and crisis management, Mr. Frankel also provides regular insight on terrorism, criminal, and intelligence related matters. Mr. Frankel also directed multiagency initiatives and major response to threats against persons and property, while developing extensive liaison programs through outreach to entities in the public, private, academic, and nonprofit sectors, as well as with community groups.



STEVE POMERANTZ

Mr. Pomerantz serves as Vice President of the Institute for the Study of Terrorism and Political Violence. Mr. Pomerantz retired from the FBI after a 27 year career during which he rose from a field investigative Special Agent to Assistant Director. He was the Assistant Director of the FBI and Chief of the Counter-Terrorism Section. During his tenure as Chief of the Counter-Terrorism Section, Mr. Pomerantz was responsible for the overall supervision of FBI domestic counter- terrorism and international counter-terrorism investigations. He was also extensively involved in law enforcement as part of the worldwide effort to combat terrorism. As an expert in terrorism, counter-terrorism and criminal justice, Mr. Pomerantz has testified before Congress and is regularly called upon by the media to comment on issues involving terrorism, counter terrorism, law, general public safety issues and the FBI.



JAMES A. GAGLIANO

James A. "Jimmy" Gagliano has some three decades' worth of practical leadership experience, serving as a U.S. Army Infantry Officer and with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). He spent 25 years as an FBI criminal investigator, SWAT Team Leader, member of the FBI's elite Hostage Rescue Team (HRT), Undercover Agent, Crisis Management Coordinator, federal Safe Streets Task Force Commander, Legal Attaché (Diplomat), and as Special Assistant (Chief-of-Staff) for the Assistant-Director-in-Charge of the FBI's largest division in New York City. Now retired from the FBI, Jimmy serves as an Adjunct Assistant Professor, instructing undergraduates in Homeland Security, Criminal Justice, Military History, and Leadership courses at St. John's University in Jamaica, Queens.



BOB RICKS

An American law enforcement agent and politician from Texas and Oklahoma. He has worked for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Governor of Oklahoma and in local law enforcement. Following his retirement from federal service, Ricks served as the Oklahoma Secretary of Safety and Security under Governor of Oklahoma Frank Keating. He was Secretary during the Keating's entire term as governor, from 1995 to 2003. Concurrent with his service as Secretary, he was also appointed by Keating as Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety.
